REMINDER - **Pet Licenses** – if you have a dog or a cat reminder pet **licenses are to be renewed annually**. \$15 if spayed or neutered or \$25 if not. As per Village Bylaw No. 240-2008 "every person within the Village of Montmartre who owns, possess or harbors a cat or dog over 3 months old, shall obtain a license …." ALSO – in accordance with Bylaw No. 284-2021 <u>cats</u> are not permitted to be running at large in the Village.
